2019 SYMPOSIUM ANNOUNCEMENT

TO ALL THE REGIONAL AND LOCAL CHAPTER CONVENERS :

The Symposia is open to the youth belonging to the following age groups, who will base their speeches on the following books:

- Group I : 06-08 yr. Illustrated Story of Chamkaur Sahib by Jagdish Singh (Punjabi & English)
 - Group II : 09-10 yr. Sikh Sakhis for the Youth Part III: Brave Sikh Women by Gurbakhsh Singh (English only)
 - Group III: 11-13 yr. Turban – The Sardari Emblem by Sarup Singh (English only)
 - Group IV: 14-17 yr. The Message of Gurbani: Jap Ji Sahib, Rehras Sahib and Sohila Sahib by Gurbakhsh Singh (English only)
 - Group V : 16-22 yr. The Ghalughara of 1984, 35th Anniversary – a Discussion (No book prescribed)
- Note on overlap of ages: 16 & 17 year old youth have the freedom to participate in either group IV or V.

EXCEPTIONS TO THE RULE: First place winners of 2018 International Sikh Youth Symposium belonging to age groups I to IV will be promoted to participate in the next higher age group this year, whereas the first place winner of 5th group shall be our honored guest with special assignment at the 2019 International Symposia. After a gap of one year in 2020 the 5th group winner shall resume his/her participation in this group if the age requirements for the said group are satisfied.

The age of any participant will be determined as of December 31, 2018. Here are some rules:

1. **PARTICIPATION RULE:** No youth can participate from other regions. However, under special circumstance a youth may be allowed to participate from another local chapter **within the region** with the permission of the regional convener. Also, any youth may be permitted to participate in a **higher age group (and not vice versa)** at the discretion of Local Unit convener. One of the two siblings belonging to same age group may participate in the higher group from the same local unit, if they so desire.
2. **REGISTRATION:** Any one can participate in the Symposium in the age group to which they belong by filling in the Registration form and paying the **registration fees of \$20.00/participant. The Local Chapter Conveners must complete the entire registration process by January 31, 2019.**
3. **DISBURSE REGISTRATION FEES PROMPTLY BY MARCH 1, 2019:** To cover the Symposium expenses at the local, regional and international levels, local Conveners will keep \$5.00/participant with them, send \$5.00/participant to their Regional Conveners and **\$10.00/participant along with a list of youth registered (Do not send their registration forms) for the Symposium to Sikh Youth Alliance of North America, 7419 Leaf Blade Ln., Wesley Chapel, FL 33545 by March 1, 2019.**

WHERE THE COMPETITION IS HELD & HOW THE PRIZES ARE AWARDED:

- a) **LOCAL LEVEL BY APRIL 30, 2019:** All registrants including Group V will compete at the LOCAL level in the city selected by the Local Convener well before the Regional competition. The first, second and third winners from group I, II, III, IV & V will be awarded trophies.

- b) **REGIONAL LEVEL BY MAY 31, 2019:** **Following will compete at regional level:**
- i. **THE FIRST PRIZE WINNERS:** From all five age groups, who participated at local level
 - ii. **SECOND PRIZE WINNERS:** If 6 to 12 youth from Age Groups I, II, III & IV and 4 to 6 from Age Group V have participated at the local level);
 - iii. **THIRD PRIZE WINNERS :** If more than 13 youth from Age Groups I, II, III & IV and 7 or more from Age Group V have participated at the local level.

The first, second and third place winners from groups I, II, III, & IV and first and second winners from group V will be awarded trophies.

- c) **RESULTS OF REGIONAL WINNERS:** **Results of first, second and third place winners of each group along with their telephone numbers and email addresses must be emailed to the National Convener at kuldeepsingh@panth.net before June 5, 2019.**

- d) **INTERNATIONAL LEVEL:** **Following will go to the International level:**
- i. **FIRST PRIZE WINNERS:** If 1 to 8 youth from Age Groups I, II, III & IV and 1 to 3 from Age Group V have participated at the Regional level
 - ii. **SECOND PRIZE WINNERS :** If 9 or more youth from Age Groups I, II, III & IV and 4 or more from Age Group V have participated at the Regional level

2019 INTERNATIONAL SIKH YOUTH SYMPOSIUM will be held in Cincinnati, Ohio at the Gurdwara Sahib from August 1 to 4, 2019. The exact location and other details will be sent to you in due course of time. The first, second and third prize winners from Groups I, II, III, IV & V will be awarded Superb Personalized Plaques. All other participants will be awarded Distinguished Speaker Award Plaques. A letter of recommendation will also be sent to the Principals/Deans of the schools/Universities of the participant.

- e) **SPECIAL AWARDS:** It is recommended to award a special prize of \$10 at LOCAL LEVEL, \$20 at REGIONAL LEVEL and \$30 at INTERNATIONAL LEVEL to all the Punjabi Speaking Participants. It is also recommended that all Kesadhaari Participants should be suitably rewarded at all three levels, whenever possible.

FOR THE ATTENTION OF ALL THE CONVENORS - REQUEST THE BOOKS FOR YOUR CENTER NOW:

We will soon be receiving all the books and we shall be shipping them over to you after receiving your request. Books for Group I are also available in PUNJABI. Please email us the number of books required (indicate Punjabi or English for Groups I only) by your Region and/or Local Chapter at kuldeepsingh@panth.net by December 31, 2018.
